- Milestone Management: Specific to your facility – what milestones are key for you to manage against. Build a roadmap specific to your site. We will discuss tracking tools to clearly know where you are – and – will you really be ready?
- Readiness: Often gut feel is the tool used to measure readiness. Put some science behind it and decide where you should be at intervals that work for you. What should we measure and we do these help predict your execution success
- Event Risk identification and Management: We often are clear what the risk to important individual jobs is – but aren’t there risks to the success of the overall event which need to be identified and managed? What impact will they have?
- Effective Event Close-out: If we are not going to really do anything with the date we collect what was the point. Do we just do “Lessons Collected” exercises? If we don’t do something about them – they are not “Lessons Learned”
